For the security of our supported Global workers and their families, other national workers, and those we are reaching with the Gospel, DCC's Global Outreach Committee has chosen not to post information about specific mission fields. The public posting of such material could endanger the people or the work being done. - DCC supports 18+ Global Workers and their families throughout the world, with a priority to those Global Workers who work with **unreached people groups** in the **10:40 Window**. In the United States we support workers on Indian Reservations as well as with inner-city youth in several cities.
- **Unreached People Groups:** An unreached people group is an ethnically and linguistically unified group of people in which less than 2% of the population are Evangelical Christians.
- **10:40 Window:** An area stretching across North Africa and Asia bounded by the 10 degree and 40 degree north latitudes representing the greatest geographical challenge to the Gospel. This area is home of the world's three great non-Christian religions, and the majority of the poorest and unreached. Roughly two-thirds of the world population lives in the 10/40 Window. Many governments in the 10/40 Window are formally or informally opposed to Christian work of any kind within their borders.
